Programme of Study	Year 5 Milestones
Beliefs, teaching and sources	Describe what a believer might learn from a religious story
	Describe some of the main beliefs of faiths, and have awareness of which faith they belong to (Christianity and Sikhism)
	Give some account of the lives of religious figures (Guru Nanak, Jesus) and explain why they are important to believers.
	Recognise that people behave in a certain way following beliefs from their holy texts.
	Name the sacred texts associated with faiths studied (Christianity and Sikhism), and give reasons why and how they are respected.
Practices and Way of Life	Describe some of the things that are the same and different from religious people
	Gather information from sources about people's religious practices and ask appropriate questions about them.
	Identify features of places of worship (for Christianity and Sikhism), and list ways they are used in religion.
Forms of expression	Use religious words to describe some of the different ways in which people show their beliefs
	Understand symbols in religion (specific reference to Christianity and Sikhism), and their origins. Explain how key symbols are used in worship.
	Explain the origins and key features of Christian festivals Christmas and Easter (including Advent, Lent etc)
Identity and Belonging	Compare some of the things that influence me with those that influence other people
Meaning, purpose and truth	Ask important questions about life and compare my ideas with those of other people
