**Purpose of Sports Premium:**

- buying quality assured materials for PE and sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs
- fund affiliation to Local and National Sporting bodies
- to develop teachers' skills and knowledge about teaching new sports,
- create opportunities for pupils to work with specialised coaches
- Cross curricular links with the English department
